- Obtained a favorable settlement for clients whose multi-million dollar claim under a life insurance policy had been denied based on alleged misrepresentations in the policy application, by obtaining discovery from the insurance company which established that it would have sold the same policy under its own internal underwriting guidelines even if the alleged misrepresentations had occurred.
- Obtained a favorable settlement after many years of litigating fraudulent transfer claims on behalf of a liquidating trustee against a large, sophisticated investment bank, in a case involving highly complicated asset backed leases and loan arrangements.
- Obtained favorable rulings on motions to dismiss various tort and breach of contract actions filed against a national telecommunications company.
